EXERCISE SETUP

- A) Set a metronome to quarter note equals60 beats per minute
- B) Play eighth notes
- C) Play everything on the G String
- D) Play everything both ascending and descending

THE EXERCISE

- 1) Begin with first finger on "C" on 5th fret
- 2) Play Lydian "whole tone" tetrachord (both ascending and descending)
- 3) Keeping first finger on C, move fourth finger down one fret and then play a major tetrachord
- Keeping first finger on C, move third finger down one fret and play a minor tetrachord
- 5) Keeping first finger on C, move second finger down one fret and play the phrygian/locrian tetrachord
- 6) Move first finger down 1 fret to B on 4th fret, leaving the other finger in place, play Lydian "whole tone" tetrachord
- 7) Repeat, moving up and down the fingerboard

NOTE: You can also begin this on the open string and play the exercise ascending
